Asia-Pacific stocks declined, with recent trade optimism already priced in and investors waiting for new developments.

U.S. stock futures were little changed after the S&P 500 and Nasdaq Composite closed at fresh record highs.

Gold prices fell as optimism over potential trade negotiations between the EU and U.S. reduced safe-haven demand.

Crude oil prices rose as optimism over U.S. trade deals boosted market sentiment.
